## Description

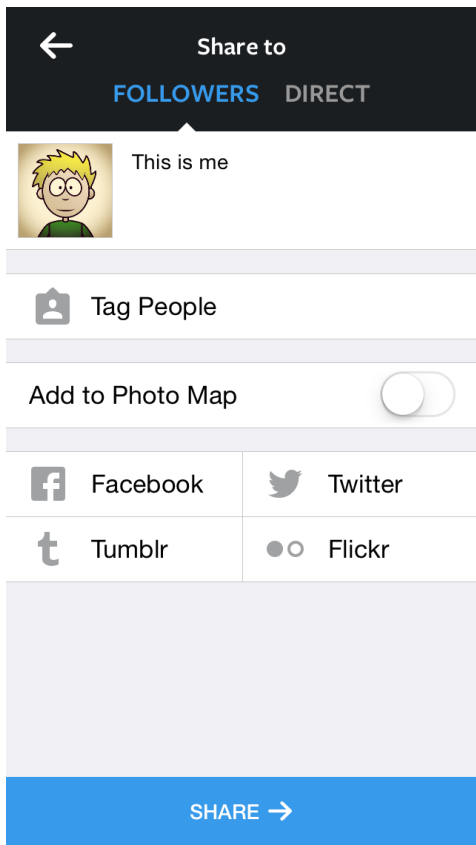
Your description is also publically available to anybody that views your profile. Make sure that it doesn't include any personal information such as your birthday, address or school name.
