## (1) Landau Forte Sixth Form Wear

**At the Landau Forte Tamworth Sixth Form, we pride ourselves on the high standards we expect of our students, which includes their appearance.**

**Landau Forte Sixth Form wear** - in black, navy or grey, may consist of a suit, skirt (knee length), or dress (knee length).

**Jacket** - all students are required to wear a tailored jacket or blazer, which must part of a suit or alongside a tailored skirt/trousers/dress.

**Shirt/Blouse** - should be in keeping with business/office dress (not t-shirt style or sports shirt) and shirts should be tucked in. Midribs should not be visible.

**Dress/Skirts** - should be at knee length.

**Trousers** – must be tailored – no leggings or jeans.

**Tights/socks** – should be plain.

**Jumpers** – in keeping with business/office dress (not a sports jumper, hooded top or sweat shirt).

The above items should be of a suitable block colour, not fluorescent and not emblazoned with stripes, patterns, slogans or logos; items should not be skin tight, low cut, strappy, off the shoulder or backless

**Tie (Academy)** – compulsory for male students and optional for female students, available to purchase from the Anglia Sports & Schoolwear [www.yourschoolwear.co.uk/](http://www.yourschoolwear.co.uk/)

**Footwear** – formal, grey/black/brown/navy/nude shoes. Trainers, material and canvas shoes, stiletto heels, backless, sling-back and toeless shoes are not acceptable.

**Hair** – hairstyles should not be extreme in style and should be of a natural colour. Hair colour which are not natural colours, for example green, pink, red, purple, yellow etc., are not allowed.

**Caps/hats** - not permitted – with the exception of dark coloured head coverings worn for religious purposes, or unless approved for medical reasons.

**Jewellery** - nose studs and other body piercings (except for earrings which must be discreet) are not acceptable and must not be worn. Body modifications, including ear expanders, are also not permitted.

**Make-up** may be worn discretely, but should not be excessive. False eyelashes are not allowed.

**Nails** – coloured nails and varnishes should not be extreme. False nails are not allowed.

**Tattoos** – should be covered.

**Academy identification card and lanyard should be worn at all times.**

## **(2) Performing Arts (Dance) / Dance Academy**

### **Compulsory Dance Kit for all practical lessons:**

- 'All black' clothing for practical dance lessons. A black leotard with footless tights, leggings or jazz pants.
- When not participating in practical sessions, students are required to change into full Academy dress.

## **(3) Sports**

### **Compulsory kit for Sports/PE:**

- Only kit specified by the Sports Dept is to be worn during practical sessions
