

# Dress Code for Students



## (1) Business/Office Dress

**Business suit** in black, navy or grey - this may consist of a trouser suit, a skirt (knee length) suit or a dress (knee length) suit.

**Shirt/Blouse** – in keeping with business/office dress (not t-shirt style or sports shirt) - shirts should be tucked in or tailored, with no logos or slogans. Midriiffs should not be visible.

**Tights/socks** – plain.

**Tie (Academy)** – (obligatory with a shirt) - available to buy from the Academy Reception.

**Footwear** – formal, grey/black/brown/navy/nude shoes. Trainers, material and canvas shoes, stiletto heels, backless, sling-back and toeless shoes are not acceptable.

**Jumpers** – in keeping with business/office dress (not a sports jumper, hooded top or sweat shirt).

**Hair** – hairstyles should not be extreme in style or colour.

**Caps/hats** - not permitted – with the exception of dark coloured head coverings worn for religious purposes, or unless approved for medical reasons.

**Jewellery** - nose studs and other body piercings (except for earrings) are not acceptable and must not be worn. Body modifications, including ear expanders, are also not permitted.

**Make-up** may be worn discretely, but should not be excessive.

**Nails** – coloured nails and varnishes should not be extreme.

**Tattoos** – should be covered.

**Lanyards embolden identification cards should be worn at all times.**

## (2) Performing Arts (Dance) / Dance Academy

**Compulsory Dance Kit for all practical lessons:**

- 'All black' clothing for practical dance lessons. A black leotard with footless tights, leggings or jazz pants.
- The Landau Forte Sixth Form zip-up jacket, embroidered with the Academy logo and student initials. This can be purchased from [www.lissport.co.uk/uniformshop](http://www.lissport.co.uk/uniformshop) and will be delivered to the Academy.

## (3) Sports

**Compulsory kit for Football Academy:**

- Burton Albion match day track suit, polo shirt, sweat shirt, training bottoms, training tshirt, training shorts, black football socks.
- All kit is embroidered with the TAG sponsor and Burton Albion logo and should be purchased through the football coach (new students should wear their own kit to begin with).
