

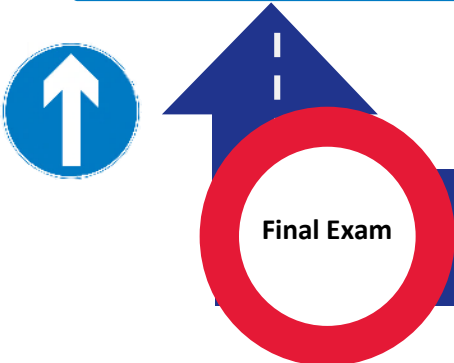
YEAR KS5 French

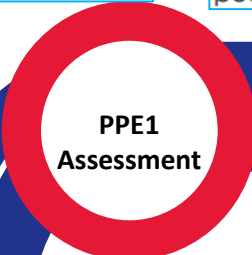
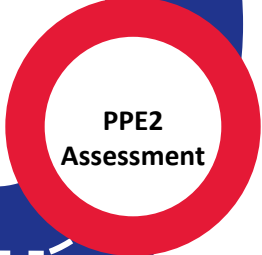
TOPIC 6 La politique et l'immigration

Different groups who are socially marginalised in the French-speaking world; measures to help people who are marginalised; contrasting attitudes to people who are marginalised.



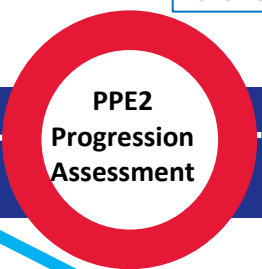
Film study

The notion of heritage on a regional and national scale in France; famous French heritage sites; how heritage impacts upon and reflects the national culture.



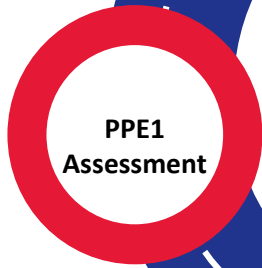
TOPIC 5 La musique francophone contemporaine
